Family Child Care Trainings at CCRC

New State Rules:

You must attend a 2-hour Family Child Care Potential Provider Meeting sponsored by the Dept. of Early Education and Care (EEC) before you can attend an Orientation Training (assistants are not required to attend the 2-hour meeting). Family Child Care Orientation: Establishing a Successful Family Child Care Home

Anyone who is interested in opening a family child care program, and/or wants to become a family child care assistant, is required by the MA Dept of Early Education & Care (EEC) to attend this 3-hour orientation in order to be eligible to apply for Family Child Care licensing. Participants will receive information regarding EEC regulations, the application and licensing procedures, and resources and supports available to family child care providers.
